



## 2022 PDS Super-Conference Safety Plan & Logistics

Our team is monitoring the government guidelines issued by the CDC, state, and local officials with regards to the ongoing situation of the coronavirus/COVID-19. Ensuring the safety of all attendees, exhibitors, and staff at our event is our top priority.

Additionally, we are coordinating with Disney’s Coronado Springs Resort to protect your health and provide you with a safe and productive environment. We will communicate any updates and changes.

### What is PDS doing?

What	Actions
Vaccination	<p>CDC recommends everyone ages 5 years and older get a Covid-19 vaccine to help protect against Covid-19.</p> <p>The state of Florida does not allow vaccine mandates or the request for proof of vaccination.</p> <p>PDS recommends attendees are fully vaccinated.</p>
Covid Testing	<p>CDC recommends that as a precaution before attending a congregated setting like a conference, COVID-19 viral testing is a screening tool to help protect the health of those around you.</p> <p>PDS is ensuring and validating that all our staff have a negative Covid antigen test result within 3 days of interacting with each other, attendees, and exhibiting staff.</p> <p>PDS is recommending all attendees and exhibitors also get tested within 3 days of arriving onsite to the conference.</p> <p><b>Picking up your badge is an acknowledgment that attendees and exhibitors have tested negative for Covid-19 within 3 days of arriving onsite.</b></p> <p>Complimentary self-administered Covid tests will be available onsite for additional testing.</p>
Social Distancing	<p>PDS will be providing ribbons during registration to attach to your badge for you to self-identify with social distancing comfort level.</p>
Hand Sanitizers	<p>PDS will provide individual hand sanitizers at each table daily.</p>
Face Coverings	<p>CDC recommends the most protective mask you can that fits well, and you will wear consistently.</p>

PDS is providing N95 masks to all attendees, exhibitors, and PDS staff.

The CDC recommends that if you do wear a cloth mask, make sure it has multiple layers of tightly woven, breathable material. Avoid wearing a cloth mask if it has gaps around the sides of the face or nose, exhalation valves or vents, single-layer fabric, thin fabric that doesn't block light, or has wet or dirty material. To get the best fit and most protection out of a cloth or disposable mask:

- Wear two masks, such as a disposable mask underneath and a cloth mask on top.
- Combine a cloth mask or disposable mask with a fitter or brace.
- Knot and tuck ear loops of a 3-ply mask where they join the edge of the mask.
- If you're wearing a disposable procedure mask, fold and tuck unneeded material under the edges.
- Wear masks that attach behind the neck and head with either elastic bands or ties, instead of ear loops.

Face coverings are required for all Guests (ages 2 and up) in all indoor locations, regardless of vaccination status. This includes upon entering and throughout all indoor attractions and indoor queues and in Disney buses, monorail, and Disney Skyliner, regardless of vaccination status. Face coverings are optional for Guests in outdoor areas.

At this time, based on guidance from health authorities, neck gaiters, open-chin, triangle bandanas and face coverings containing valves, mesh material or holes of any kind are not acceptable face coverings.

Costume masks are not considered appropriate and are prohibited from being worn, in alignment with Disney's [existing rules](#).

Face coverings may have an integrated transparent plastic panel to aid in viewing the wearer's mouth. These face coverings should:

- Be a fabric face covering featuring a solid plastic panel containing no openings that is attached to the fabric on all sides using tight knit stitching
- Meet all face covering requirements listed above

All Disney's Coronado Springs staff are required to wear company-issued face coverings.

Self-Checks	<p>PDS staff will self-check in hotel rooms for symptoms of illness, per CDC definition, before each shift and will stay in their room if they are not feeling well.</p> <p>PDS is asking all attendees and exhibiting staff to self-check prior to leaving your hotel room.</p> <p>The Coronavirus Self-Checker is an interactive clinical assessment tool that will assist individuals ages 13 and older, and parents and caregivers of children ages 2 to 12 on deciding when to seek testing or medical care if they suspect they or someone they know has contracted COVID-19 or has come into close contact with someone who has COVID-19.</p> <p>The online, mobile-friendly tool asks a series of questions, and based on the user’s responses, provides recommended actions and resources.</p> <p>Click on the <a href="#">Coronavirus Self-Checker tool</a> to help you make decisions on when to seek testing and medical care or attend sessions.</p> <p><a href="#">Symptoms of Covid-19</a></p>

Online Check-in	We strongly recommend that you use <a href="#">Online Check-In Service</a> prior to your stay.
Automatic Check-out	On your scheduled checkout day, you'll be automatically checked out of your room—so you don't have to visit the Front Desk (unless you have unresolved charges to your Disney Resort hotel folio).
Temperature Screenings	<p>Attendees may be required to undergo temperature screenings with no-touch thermometers before entry to Disney's Coronado Springs Resort, convention area, and table-service restaurants at Disney Resort hotels.</p> <p>Based on guidance from health authorities, anyone displaying a temperature of 100.4 F (38 C) or above will be directed to an additional location for rescreening and assistance. Those with temperatures 100.4 F (38 C) or above will not be allowed entry; those in their party will not be allowed entry either.</p> <p>Before attendees leave home, they should check the temperatures of everyone in their party – including themselves – as an extra layer of precaution.</p>
Hand Sanitizers / Hands-Free	The number of hand sanitizer locations throughout Disney's Coronado Springs Resort has been increased.
Coffee Stations & Breaks	<p>Touchless self-serve coffee stations will be available. These hot beverage stations will feature individually wrapped, disposable cups and touchless coffee dispensers. Individually wrapped coffee condiments will be provided.</p> <p>Individual bottled and canned beverages will also be available.</p> <p>Food items will include a variety of individually wrapped items.</p>
Disney Resort Hotel Dining	Planning to dine at a table-service restaurant in a Disney Resort hotel? A confirmed dining reservation is required for day Guests (those not staying overnight) and is highly recommended for Guests staying overnight at a Disney Resort hotel.

Scannable Codes for Select Restaurant Menus	At select table-service restaurants, attendees can use their own mobile device to scan a code to access a digital menu. Disney Springs Dining	Select dining locations at Disney Springs are currently accepting reservations for all Guests up to 60 days in advance. Check availability and make reservations online now.
Pools & Recreation	Feature pools may operate with reduced hours; leisure pools are open 24 hours a day. Pools are operating with reduced capacity and mobile waitlists may be used, giving Guests the option to receive an alert and return when space is available. Select poolside activities may be available at select Resort hotels.
Bell Service	Bell Services will deliver luggage to rooms, but will not escort Guests
Laundry Services	Dry-cleaning and valet laundry services will be temporarily unavailable; self-service laundry will remain available.
